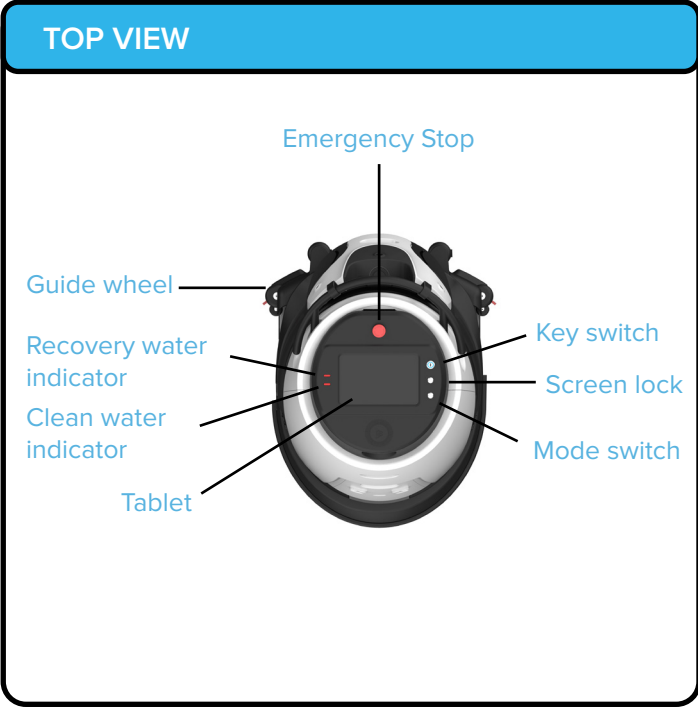



USER MANUAL ECO BOT 50




OPERATION GUIDE

1.




Turn on the Eco Bot 50 using the key and wait 30 seconds for the interface to turn on.

2.




Select your account & enter your credentials.

3.




Once the machine has turned on it will report on the status of the consumable parts. Ensure these are of a suitable status & press ok.

4.




Fill the clean water tank using a bucket or hose.

5.




You can adjust the configurations of water & suction power using the interface

6.




Select 'auto mode' or 'manual mode'

7.




You can stop manual mode quickly using the "Quick Stop" button on the interface.

8.




You can change the cleaning task by selecting the "change task" button. This will display all the pre-mapped tasks.

9.




If the machine shows a red "Not Ready" alert. Please ensure that your machine is in the correct start point and the start button should turn green.

10.



You are able to pause the cleaning process or use the emergency stop machine at anytime during the operation.



DAILY MAINTENANCE


PLEASE ENSURE THAT THE FOLLOWING IS COMPLETED AFTER EVERY USE.

Stop the machine and ensure that the power is off.

Empty and clean out both water tanks.

Clean the filters, squeegee blades & pad/brushes as required.

Park the machine in a safe level place and put it on charge.



Empty the water out of the tank. Take out the filter bag and wash it.



Use the tool to take out the filters to clean or replace. The use the water pipe to wash the tanks



Check the cylindrical mesh filter and replace if not in good condition. Hold the edge of the brush and push down.



Check for any rubbish on the brush (make sure power is off). Then insert the plug into the Eco Bot and begin charging.
